

Call for applications: Senior Academic Position at the Haim & Joan Constantiner School of Education, Tel Aviv University

The Haim & Joan Constantiner School of Education invites applications for a tenure-track position in the area of **learning disorders and educational counseling**, effective from October 2026. The position is open to outstanding researchers whose main field of research is relevant to these areas.

Job Description and Requirements:

The candidate must be an outstanding researcher whose research concerns the department's topics: educational counseling; learning disorders; social, emotional, and/or cognitive development; resilience, endurance, and trauma; parenthood and guidance of parents; and populations with special characteristics (gifted, developmental disorders, populations at risk, etc.); and topics adjacent to these.

The candidates must hold a Ph.D, and except exceptional cases, must have done post-doctoral studies. They should exhibit international-level academic excellence, and an ability and willingness to raise research funding and to teach and mentor students.

The successful candidate will be expected to research issues pertaining to the topics above, teach courses (mainly in Hebrew) in the school of education programs, mentor graduate students, and serve in the school committees.

The Faculty of Humanities at Tel Aviv University is interested in increasing diversity, broadly defined, and recruiting new faculty members representing a diverse, multicultural society.

This announcement applies to men and women equally. The position is open to all candidates who fulfil the above criteria.

The position will be filled according to the candidate's qualifications and the School of Education's needs. The school reserves the right to independently locate individuals who will be added to the list of candidates. The Haim & Joan Constantiner School of Education, the Faculty of Humanities and Tel Aviv University are not obligated to appoint any of the candidates who apply for this position. Salary and employment conditions will conform to Tel Aviv University regulations. The appointment procedure will be carried out according to the rules and regulations of Tel Aviv University and are subject to the approval of the University's authorities. The academic rank will be determined according to the candidate's qualifications.

This is a tenure-track position, which may lead to a tenured appointment following the probationary period. Salary and conditions will conform to Tel Aviv University regulations. Appointment procedures will be carried out in accordance with the rules and regulations of Tel Aviv University, and are subject to the approval of the university authorities

The application process:

1. A cover letter referring to the candidate's academic trajectory (up to two pages).

3. A short description of planned future research (up to one page).

2. Reference Letters

Candidates who proceed to the second stage of evaluation will be asked to have three reference letters from senior researchers, sent directly to the above address, and to attach short syllabi for three relevant courses.

At the end of this stage, we will formulate a short list of candidates.

3. Interviews + Job Talk

The shortlisted candidates will be invited to interviews and will be asked to deliver a talk to committee members, faculty, and students, At the beginning of June, 2026.
